

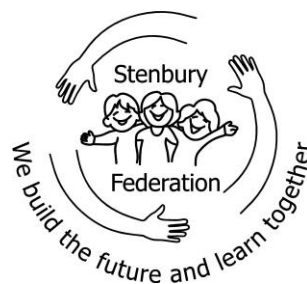

RE: New Classrooms and Uniform

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for coming in to school in September due to the changes in location of some of the classrooms. Reception and Year 1 will be sharing the current Year 1 and 2 classrooms and Year 2 will be moving into the current Reception classroom. All other classrooms will remain the same.

Year 1, in the morning come round onto the big playground. When the bell goes the children are to come up the steps to the current Year 2 classroom door. Now the children are in Key Stage 1 we ask parents to say goodbye at the door and for the children to come in to class independently. This is a great opportunity for the children to build on their independence.

Year 2, please come round the front of the school and to the gate which is currently the entrance used for Reception. When the bell goes, children can come in the current Reception door independently. May I remind parents that the toys and equipment that are in the waiting area belong to Pre-School and must **not** be played with.

Years 3, 4 and 5/6 will come to the same entrances.

At home time, **all** year groups will be collected from the main playground. Parents, please wait for the staff to send your children to you so that we can make sure all children go to their responsible adult.

I also wanted to inform parents that children in Years Reception, 1 and 2 all wear the polo shirts as their uniform and only Key Stage 2 children wear shirts and ties. A copy of the uniform list has been attached for any other queries which may arise regarding uniform. We look forward to seeing you all in your correct uniform in September.
