Dear Parents and Carers,

I can't believe that another week has passed already. The children have been hard at work and have shown a good attitude to their learning. Thank you to parents who have supported the trip to the fire station and all the sporting events that have taken place this week. It is greatly appreciated.

Mr Snow has started the week with an assembly on presentation; talking with the children about expectations on how they present themselves and their work. Children are expected to be wearing the correct school uniform as stated in our school prospectus which can be found on our website. This includes black school shoes; and grey trousers, skirts or pinafores — no trainers or jeans are permitted. Also, socks and tights need to be either white or grey.
