#### Writing

'This term we will be looking at the The Smeds and the Smoos and will be exploring the different settings and main characters in the book. We will be looking at prefixes and suffixes. The children in the end will write their own diary entry from the point of view of one of the characters.

We will also be looking at Jack and the Beanstalk story where the children will use different previous skills they have learnt and will write their own narrative of the story.

The children will be concentrating on being secure in using Capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

### DISCOVER: (Curriculum Focus)

#### History:


Year 1 will be learning about Queen Victoria reign and how she became Queen. We will also be looking at Queen Victoria family and the dynamites in that family. We will also be looking Osborne House and Swiss Cottage and who lived there and what was the house like at that time.

### Mathematics:

Over the next half term, Year1 The children will be introduced to adding and substations with money, measuring lengths and heights. We will be looking at clocks, half past and o'clock. We will be continuing with working with mass and looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We will be concentrating on:

Addition and subtraction (money), Measurement's lengths/heights, Measurement- time, Addition and subtraction with mass, Multiplication and division and Geometry.

Children will continue to focus on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and working on their number bonds to 10 and 20.

### Physical Education:

In PE, Year 1 will be focusing on Multi skills (Fundamentals of movement Agility, Balance, Coordination)

### EXPLORE: (Curriculum support)
