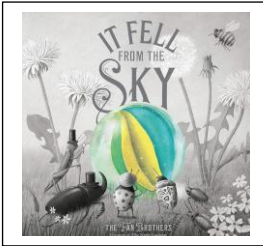


English:

This term, we will be reading the book "It Fell from the Sky" by The Fan Brothers. The children will be recapping their knowledge of noun, adjectives and verbs and then focus on writing expanded noun phrases.

These expanded noun phrases will then be used to create a character description of the Spider from the book. Handwriting will be a focus for the term as well as ensuring capital letters and full stops are being used.



Explore: Geography - Rivers

Year 3 will be exploring mountains and rivers in this unit and will be looking more closely at:

- What a mountain is
- What mountains are used for
- Where the mountains are in the UK
- The tallest mountain in Europe
- The main features of a river

Mathematics:

The children will be completing work to further develop their fluency, reasoning and problem-solving skills. They will also continue to develop their times table knowledge and mental maths skills. The main areas that will be covered are:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and subtraction
- Measurement – money
- Multiplication and division
