Autumn Term 1

English:



In English, the children will look at different texts, focusing on making predictions, creating their own stories and using inverted commas for speech. They will end by writing their own adventure narrative.

They will also develop their skills to write informatively about a local geographical feature on the Isle of Wight

EXPLORE (Curriculum Focus)

Geography:

In Geography, we will be focussing in our beautiful island and where we are located in relation to other counties and major cities in the UK. We will be look at physical feature of the island and what makes it unique as well as the human geography of the island.

Mathematics

The children will start the term looking at place value and recognising value of each digit in 3 or 4 digit number, comparing and ordering numbers to 100 and beyond. They will develop their estimating skills and be able to place a number on a number line.

They will then go on to look at addition and subtraction using measurements and will develop their knowledge of money and length.

Physical Education:

In PE, the children will focus on the rules and skills required to play tag rugby including passing.

Religious Education:

In RE the key concept that the children will be exploring is sacred. They will discuss what a sacred place is and their importance to different people.

Modern Foreign Languages:

The children will be looking at Greetings and introducing yourself, numbers, locating France and Paris on a map and understanding and responding to classroom instructions.

STEM

Science:

In science our bug question is **What do our bodies do with the food we eat?** We will look at how food travels through our body starting with the mouth and teeth and moving through the digestive system.

Design Technology:

Toward the end of term we will have a project day where we create a class information book with leaver and linkages. This will bring our learning in English, History, Geography and art together to publish an interactive non-fiction text that can be shared across the school.

CREATE (Curriculum support)

Art: The children will be producing art work based on our island and water using their knowledge gained through topic and English lessons to work across the curriculum.

Music: Year 4 will focus on body and tuned percussion using the rainforest as a stimulus. This will be taught through Kapow.

PSHE:

In PSHE we will be focusing on settling back in to school, our wellbeing and developing a growth mindset. We will be doing this alongside a SCARF programme and focusing on our rights and responsibilities and Healthy Relationships.

DISCOVER (Curriculum support)

In History, we will be discovering how our land on the Isle of Wight has changed over time and how we have adapted to use the land differently. This will be supported by our learning in Geography, English and Art.
