

English:

This term Year 4 will use Levi Pinfold's Greenling as inspiration for their writing. They will identify and write a persuasive speech before performing in to be recorded.



They will then look at the story from a different character perspective and go on to write an interview transcript. They will then identify the feature of an online article before composing their own online persuasive article.

In guided reading they will continue to study a range of texts following the Fred Teaches programme of study. They will focus on the environment, female astronauts, UK destinations: Wales and the Olympics.

Physical Education:

Striking net games - Tennis.

In PE the children will develop their ball and racket control as well as their understanding of the rules of tennis.



Religious Education:

The theme of RE this term is **Ceremonies – Death**

Ceremonies – Christianity.

The children will research the funerals and death ceremonies to themselves and Christians.



Modern Foreign Languages: French

In French the children will develop their language around weather. They will also explore the vocabulary around this summer's Euro's.

PSHE:

Following the SCARF programme of study, the children will be focusing on **Growing and Changing**. They will discuss physical changes to their bodies, the differences between men and women, as well as emotion change that can happen too.

Computing:

This term Year 4 will be looking repetition in games (programming). They will be able to plan a program to achieve a given outcome (a game) and evaluate and debug their code.

Summer Term 2

Discover and Explore (Curriculum support)

History

The children continue with their learning about the Anglo-Saxons and the spread of Christianity during this time. They will also study Aalfred the Great and the end of the Anglo-Saxon reign in Britain.

In addition, they children delve in the past life of their Artist - Veronika Richterova

Geography

Complementing their CREATE curriculum, the children will study where Veronika Richterova's work is popular and its origin.

Mathematics:

This term the children have the **Multiplication Tables Check**.

They will also study a wide range of topics including:
- Fractions – finding equivalent fractions and decimals
- Solving sum and difference problems using different representations.
- Formal methods of multiplication and division

STEM

Science:

Year 4 children will conduct an investigation into the viscosity of liquids. They will plan and carry out an investigation, collect, analyse and evaluate data and present their finding on the absorption of liquids with different viscosities.



Create

Art and Design:

Year 4 will study Veronika Richterova and her works. They will make specific choices between different processes and materials, combine different materials in different ways and focus on the transformation of one thing into another.



Music:

Year 4 will study Samba and Carnival Sounds. They will be able to identify the main features, play a syncopated rhythmic a soloist and as part of an ensemble and compose a rhythmic break.
