

English (Reading and writing):

Text drivers/books to share:

- Queen Victoria's Bathing Machine
- How the Wright Brothers Conquered the Skies

Reading: This term, we are beginning to look at non-fiction books. We are also working on our reading comprehension skills.

Writing: Using our text drivers we will be writing our own non-fiction leaflets. We will be focussing on sentence structure using colourful semantics. The children will be using their phonics skills to help with their writing and spelling.

Physical Education (Dance and movement):

The children will develop their movement skills in balance, agility, and coordination. In dance, they will learn to perform dances using simple movement patterns.

Religious Education:

In RE this term, we will be looking at both Judaism and Christianity with a particular focus on how light can be represented symbolically.

Modern Foreign Languages:

For French, we will be learning how to say our age and personal information. The children will be extending their numbers up to 10 in French.

CREATE: (Curriculum Support)

Art: This term we are beginning to record simple media explorations in a sketch book. This will enable the children to develop a wide range of art and design techniques. This will be linked to Queen Victoria's love of sketching.

Music: We will continue to follow our music programme on charanga and learn about the rhythm and beat of the music.

Discover: History (Curriculum

Focus)

Monarchs: We will be comparing the lives and reigns of Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria. The class will timeline events throughout their lives and identify key roles of monarchs. This topic helps the children to develop an understanding of British values.

Mathematics:


This term we will continue to develop our skills with number sense and place value. We are going to move on towards measurement which will provide the children with essential life skills.

Children will be given the opportunity to use concrete objects and manipulatives to help them understand the new concepts. Alongside this, children will use pictorial representations to help them reason and solve problems.

STEAM:

Science: This half term, we will be building on and developing our knowledge on materials acquired before the break. We will be looking at how a range of materials are used in day-to-day life. The children will be developing their scientific enquiry skills and undertaking their own experiments.

Computing: This term the children will develop their understanding of a range of tools used for digital painting. They then use these tools to create their own digital paintings, while gaining inspiration from a range of artists' work. The unit concludes with the class considering their preferences when painting with and without the use of digital devices.

PSHE:

We will continue to follow our PSHE programme on SCARF. This term we will be looking at healthy relationships.

This term, we will be exploring the similarities and differences in relation to places, objects, materials and living things.
